CDM Regulations Guidelines



In April 2015 the CDM regulations were introduced for the event industry. These regulations will be enforced during the build-up and breakdown times of UK Dairy Day.

Construction/De-Construction Times

During the build-up and breakdown, known as “construction phase”, all personnel on site will be required to wear high vis jackets and safety footwear.

- 8am on Sunday 12th September to 10pm on Tuesday 14th September 2021
- 7pm until 10pm on Wednesday 15th September 2021
- 8am to 10pm on Thursday 16th September 2021

Dressing/Undressing Times

During the dressing/undressing stages no construction work is allowed on the stand, during these times only low risk work can be undertaken on the stand like putting up pull ups, setting up display tables, putting out literature, promotional items etc.

- Event Day Wednesday 15th September 2021 from 7am to 8am and from 5.30pm to 7pm

Arriving on site

On arrival please report to the security gate where you will need to state which stands you are building, if a Risk Assessment & CDM Regs Online Form has not been completed in advance for the trade stand you are building then a CDM form will need to be completed at the gate before access is permitted.

All personnel will be given a wrist band to worn at all times and must wear a high-vis jacket during the ‘construction phase’ which is build up and breakdown.
